The Goldfields Arts Centre is owned by the Department of Training and Workforce Development and operated by the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder. The Goldfields Arts Centre was opened in November 1993 and has become a part of Kalgoorlie's landscape and lifestyle. The Centre was built by Kalgoorlie College, which later became a part of Curtin University of Technology. As recently as the 1st September 2013 has seen the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder take over staff and day to day management of the Goldfields Arts Centre while the Department of Training and Workforce Development have taken ownership of the building. The Goldfields Arts Centre (GAC) can sell tickets to your event, on your behalf, for a small fee. The Centre is already a ticketing agent for many event organisers and is a long-term agent for local companies/groups. This beautiful 700 seat tiered auditorium is available for shows, seminars and a number of other activities/events. Known as being one of the best regional theatres in Australia, the Goldfields Arts Centre has a great reputation with all touring shows and promoters.
