Museum in Perth, WA The Western Australian Museum – Perth has now closed to the public while we create the New Museum for WA, scheduled to open in the Perth Cultural Centre in 2020. This does not mean the WA Museum is closing for business. You can still find us in a range of surprising and unusual places including the Perth Concert Hall – and coming soon – our new Discovery Zone in the State Library of WA. Plus visit our museums in Fremantle, and our regional museums in Geraldton, Kalgoorlie-Boulder and Albany all of which are continuing to present a huge range of Museum experiences and activities to enjoy. Although we are now closed, we offer a virtual walk around the Perth museum. This collection of panoramas captured the WA Museum – Perth before the decant began, and so preserves the site as it stood prior to the dismantling of displays and exhibition spaces. High quality images were taken of all of the galleries: Katta Djinoong, the Mammal, Bird and Butterfly Galleries, the WA Land and People Gallery, the Dampier Marine Gallery, the Diamonds to Dinosaurs Gallery, and so on – as well as images of other spaces such as the foyer, grounds, café, and Discovery Centre.
