Music venue in Perth, WAPerth Concert Hall is renowned for having one of the finest acoustics in the southern hemisphere. The concert hall is the home and serves as the primary performance venue for the West Australian Symphony Orchestra (WASO), and hosts a number of diverse performances and events all year round. Perth Concert Hall was designed by architects Jeffery Howlett and Don Bailey, with construction and completion carried out by Sabemo (WA). The building was opened on Australia Day in January 1973 and serves as a prime example of the “brutalist” mid-century architecture style. The London Symphony, Chicago and Berlin Philharmonic Orchestras are among the great classical ensembles that have performed at the venue, as have many of the world’s best contemporary artists including; Ray Charles, PJ Harvey, Nina Simone, Sting, Tim Minchin and KD Lang. Located in the heart of Perth, Perth Concert Hall is the performance home of the West Australian Symphony Orchestra. The venue hosts concerts of a range of other classical orchestras including Musica Viva and Australian Chamber Orchestra, as well as a range of pop and contemporary acts and other events and corporate functions. Perth Concert Hall promotes a workplace that actively seeks to include, welcome and value unique contributions of all people. Perth Concert Hall encourages people with disability, Indigenous Australians, young people and people from culturally diverse backgrounds to apply for available positions.
