Museum in Pakenham, VIC The Museum is housed in the 1912 Shire Office which have been relocated for use by the Society and have been faithfully restored by the Cardinia Council. The collection includes artefacts, papers, family histories, books and photographs mainly relevant to the original Berwick Shire, much of which is on display. Established in 1961 as the Shire of Berwick Historical Society, this Society operates a Museum containing objects, photographs and documents about the Berwick and Pakenham districts. Our Collection includes around 2000 items, many photographs. Good collection of local area. Local history books produced "In the Wake of the Pack Tracks", "North of the Line" "Early Days of Berwick", "Oak trees and hedges" and "Berwick Nostalgia". Collection of canes (approx 200). Railway memorabilia now on loan to Puffing Billy.
