Our school was the first to use two-way radio broadcasts to help with the education of students living in remote areas and unable to attend face-toface lessons from typical schools. Since 2006, we rely completely in satellite technology to conduct our classes. Our educational services cover an area of around 1.3 square kilometers. As a visitor, you will be able to experience our Visitor Centre, an interpretive centre that offers our visitors a virtual journey in "The World's Largest Classroom". Our gift shop has a wide array of special merchandise that helps us to support financially our projects and enrich our school's program.
